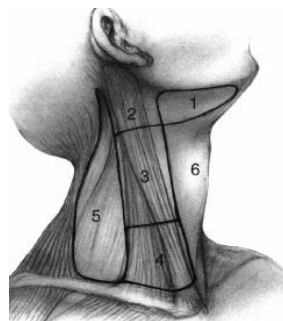

It consists of a series of lectures in the morning followed by hands-on cadaver dissections on the afternoon. The emphasis of this course will be on management strategies and operative techniques.

Objectives:

The participant of this course is expected to fulfill the following objectives:

- Appreciate the surgical anatomy of the head and neck
- Be familiar with imaging techniques for head and neck cancer.
- Know the surgical procedures involved in the selected head and neck procedures
- Understand the principles of head and neck flap such as pectoralis muscle myocutaneous flap, deltopectoral flap and submental flap.
- Understand the principles of microvascular surgery

Lectures:

- Neck dissection
- Management of parotid neoplasms, oral cavity neoplasms ,thyroid neoplasm, retrosternal goiter, parapharyngeal space tumors, sinonasal malignancies, sarcoma and melanoma
- Reconstruction of mandibular and maxillary defects
- Head and neck flaps
- Laryngectomy and surgical voice restoration
- Endoscopic nasopharyngectomy
- Craniofacial resection open/endoscopic approaches
- Operating in post chemoradiotherapy patients ó tips and pitfalls
- Role of neck dissection in management of patients being treated with chemoradiotherapy
- Operative video

Cadaver dissection:

Course participants will be taken through the procedures in step by step manner. The dissection course includes parotidectomy, submandibular gland excision, various types of mandibulectomy and maxillectomy, excision of tongue lesions, thyroidectomy, various types of neck dissection, laryngectomy , raising deltopectoral flap, pectoralis major muscle myocutaneous flap and submental flap etc. In addition to endoscopic nasopharyngectomy demonstration.
